Registering as a resident:

- If you plan to reside in Spain more than 3 months, you are required by the Spanish authorities to register as a resident
- To do so, you will need to make an appointment online and then attend the *Oficina de Extranjeros* (immigration office) or designated police station in your local area
- Once registered, you will be given a green card or certificate with your NIE number on it
- You must also register on the padrón, which is the local register at your town hall
